**\*Students studying at any of the commonwealth campuses should take COMM 160 in their 4<sup>th</sup> semester while still at any of the commonwealth campuses.\***

**\*Students studying at any of the commonwealth campuses that do not offer COMM 260W will take that course 5<sup>th</sup> semester upon arrival to University Park. In place of COMM 260W students should take a general education quantification course (GQ) 3<sup>rd</sup> or 4<sup>th</sup> semester. COMM 260W will be taken in place of COMM 271 5<sup>th</sup> semester. COMM 271 should then be taken 6<sup>th</sup> semester in place of the general education quantification course (GQ).\***

**\*Effective FALL 2012, all incoming Schreyer Honors College freshmen at University Park will take ENGL/CAS 137H in the fall semester and ENGL/CAS 138T in the spring semester. These courses carry GWS designation and replace both ENGL 030 and CAS 100.**
